

Alumni Committee LMC Purpose Statement

The Alumni Committee of Leadership Mitchell County was formed to reconnect and engage LMC Alumni with other LMC Alumni, renew a sense of civic purpose and to provide continuing education and leadership opportunities.

Proposed Alumni Committee LMC Action Steps to achieve our purpose.

1. Organize an annual Alumni LEAP event to reconnect and reenergize.
2. Provide to least one other LEAP event in every year for above.
3. Establish a newsletter to promote leadership, highlight alumni and their accomplishments and list civic leadership opportunities in the NCK area.
4. Establish a speaker's bureau to promote leadership and LMC.
5. Establish a financial base for scholarships for leadership education.
6. To connect Alumni with current class by engaging them in the Celebration aspects of the year...picnic and graduation.
7. Provide an opportunity for Alumni to come together on a community project on an annual basis.
8. Establish quarterly meetings.
9. Offer Alumni engagement opportunities on the other board committees: Curriculum, Recruitment, and Alumni.

Alumni Meetings

The Alumni will be offered quarterly meetings with short Alumni meeting, leadership educational offering and opportunities for networking and reconnecting. At the 4th quarter meeting, those present will establish the plan for the following year. At this time it is a breakfast, lunch, after hours and the LEAP event to offer at least one time each year that would coordinate with anyone's schedule.
